

- State Art Collection, Dresden 08.02 (flood damage)

MEPPI Preserving the Photographic Heritage of the Middle East:

MEPPI is a strategic drive to promote the preservation and awareness of photograph collections in the broad Middle East. The Arab Image Foundation, the Metropolitan Museum of Art and the Getty Conservation Institute are partners in this initiative.



National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH):

The NEH announced a new grant program, called "Common Heritage," that will bring to light historical records and artifacts currently hidden in family attics and basements across the country and make them digitally available to the wider public and for posterity.

Official Projects for Digitizing Cultural Heritage

Many museums, art and culture archives, libraries and scientific institutions have started large-scale projects for digitizing historic and contemporary photos, documents, artworks, natural and artificial objects.

World Digital Library: An international digital library operated by UNESCO and the United States Library of Congress, which intends to make significant primary materials from cultures around the world available on the Internet, free of charge and in multilingual format.



Europeana: An internet portal, which acts as an interface to millions of books, paintings, films, museum objects and archival records that have been digitized throughout Europe.



Market Potential for cultural and historical Institutions





The German Digital Library (DDB) is a digital library, which is supposed to provide a network for **30.000 German cultural and scientific institutions.** A shared platform is planned to offer access for the public.

This digital library will offer free access to **copies of books**, **fine art**, **notes**, **music and film** to all citizens. The facility will provide access to free cultural asset, while "the digital control over the ... cultural heritage remains in public responsibility". In addition, the protection of national cultural heritage against disasters like the collapse of the Cologne City Archives or the fire of the Anna Amalia Library in Weimar is a task which has been explicitly mentioned.




